The seminar will be organized via the Zoom platform and will be recorded. You can join using the following link:


For security reasons, the link is not included in this programme but will be sent to participants upon registration.

In order to ensure the seminar runs optimally with room for debate and reflection on the issues involved, we ask you to follow these rules for participation:

- b. The seminar will open in time to check that all of the participants have been able to connect and comply with the appropriate technical conditions. As of 9:00 a.m. the session will open and we ask that participants connect at least 20-30 minutes before the scheduled starting time in order to handle any technical difficulties participants may have.

- e. The conference will take place in Spanish with simultaneous translation into English.
